

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has assigned 'WCRME 3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the ME Rating to Thai Plastic Industries (hereinafter referred as "TPI" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information upto the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Owned business premises and storage facility
- Satisfactory banking relationship
- Good mortgage security coverage against loan
- Good business network
- Good Profitability margin
- Good liquidity position with short cash conversion cycle
- Low levered capital structure
- Comfortable interest coverage position
- Maintained sound business relation with supplier & buyer

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- No insurance coverage for the inventory in stock
- Lack of disclosure in the financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system

The SME rating implies that the enterprise is adjudged to above average level of credit worthiness in relation to other small enterprises.

WCRCL also viewed the enterprise with "Stable" outlook and believes that TPI will be able to maintain its good fundamentals in the foreseeable future.
