

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has re-affirmed 'WCRSE 3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Bikrampur Fall Bhander (hereinafter referred as "BFB" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Satisfactory banking relationship

- Low levered capital structure

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Small scale in the business
- Tight liquidity position with long cash conversion cycle
- Low disclosure of financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system
