

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed **WCRSE 3** (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **Parvej Badam Mill** (hereinafter referred to as 'PBM' or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up—to the date of the rating declaration.

The above ratings have been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which good market reputation, low levered concern, long experience track of the owner, and owned shop facility. However, the above factors are constrained to some extent by manual accounting system, small scale operation, tight liquidity position with long cash conversion cycle, lack of insurance coverage, and low profit margin.

The SME rating implies that the enterprise is adjudged to above average level of credit worthiness in relation to other SE's / ME's.

WCRCL also viewed the enterprise with "Stable" outlook and believes that PBM will be able to maintain its good fundamentals in the foreseeable future.
