

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed **WCRSE 3** (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **Meghna Rice Agency** (hereinafter referred to as 'MRA or ''The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up–to the date of the rating declaration.

The above ratings have been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which good banking relationship, experienced and proactive management, good interest coverage position, and good position in value to loan ratio. However, the above factors are constrained to some extent by manual accounting system, stressed liquidity position with long cash conversion cycle, small scale operation, and poor disclosure of financial statements.

The SME rating implies that the enterprise is adjudged to above average level of credit worthiness in relation to other SE's / ME's.

WCRCL also viewed the enterprise with "Stable" outlook and believes that MRA will be able to maintain its good fundamentals in the foreseeable future.
