

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **Bismillah Enterprise** (hereinafter referred as "BE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.
