

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed 'WCRSME4' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Four) rating under the SME Rating to K.K. Enterprise (hereinafter referred as "KKE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:
