

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has assigned 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Ibn Sina Homeo Hall (hereinafter referred as "ISHH" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.
