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

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed **WCRSME3** (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small & Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **New Sanjida Enterprise** (hereinafter referred as "NSE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Satisfactory banking relationship
- Good business network
- Good interest coverage position
- Low levered capital structure

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Tight liquidity position with long cash conversion cycle
- No insurance coverage
- Low disclosure of financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system
