
RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small And Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Pavel Bricks-2 (hereinafter referred as "PB2" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Tight liquidity position considering long cash conversion cycle
- No insurance coverage for the inventory in stock
- Manual accounting system
