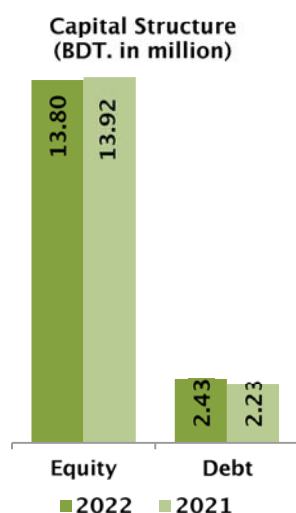

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed **‘WCRSE 3’** (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **Shaikh Wahid Iron Store** (hereinafter referred as **“SWIS”** or “The Enterprise”) based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Satisfactory banking relationship
- Good mortgage security coverage against loan
- Good interest coverage position
- Low levered capital structure

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Tight liquidity position with long cash conversion cycle
- Low disclosure of financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system

The SME rating implies that the enterprise is adjudged to **above average level** of credit worthiness in relation to other small enterprises.

WCRCL also viewed the enterprise with “Stable” outlook and believes that **SWIS** will be able to maintain its good fundamentals in the foreseeable future.
