
RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has assigned 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Sabuj Sikder & Sons (hereinafter referred as "SSS" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Low disclosure in the financial statements
- Small Scale in the business
- Tight liquidity position considering long cash conversion cycle
- No insurance coverage for the inventory in stock
- Manual accounting system
