

### **RATING RATIONALE**

WCRCL has reaffirmed 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small And Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Sumon Enterprise (hereinafter referred as "SE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Good interest coverage position

- Low levered capital structure

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Inventory holding risk
- Tight liquidity position
- Low disclosure of financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system
