

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has reaffirmed 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Tahmid Enterprise (hereinafter referred as "TE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Satisfactory banking relationship
- Low levered capital structure
- Good security coverage against loan
- Good loan utilization ratio
- Good liquidity position with short cash conversion cycle

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- No insurance coverage
- Low disclosure of financial statements
- Low management information system (MIS) and Manual accounting system
