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

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has upgraded 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to Abdullah Food Industries (hereinafter referred as "AFI" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up-to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been reaffirmed based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Good mortgage security coverage against loan

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Low disclosure in the financial statements
- Highly levered capital structure
- Tight liquidity position considering long cash conversion cycle
- Manual accounting system

The SME rating implies that the enterprise has above average credit quality.
