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

RATING RATIONALE

WCRCL has assigned 'WCRSME3' (pronounced as WASO Credit Rating Small and Medium Enterprise Three) rating under the SME Rating to **Shahjahan Enterprise** (hereinafter referred as "SE" or "The Enterprise") based on its financial and other relevant qualitative and quantitative information up—to the date of the rating issuance.

The above rating has been assigned based on the fundamentals of the enterprise which includes:

- Experienced and skilled management
- Good business network and maintained sound business relation with supplier & buyer
- Low levered capital structure
- Sales revenue was increased

However, the above rating has been moderated to some extent due to some factors like:

- Poor disclosure in the financial statements
- Tight liquidity position considering long cash conversion cycle
- No insurance coverage for the inventory in stock

The SME rating implies that the enterprise has above average credit quality.
